- UCI student **applicants** were **ABOVE** the national applicants average score in **ALL** subjects of the MCAT
- UCI student applicants accepted were **ABOVE** the national average matriculated score in **ALL** subjects of the MCAT
- 29% UCI 2013 applicants were re-applicants. Of which 32% of the re-applicants were admitted in the medical school.
- The MODE for admitted UCI applicants is 3.9 Science GPA and 3.8 CUM GPA with MCAT score of 31.
- The MODE for UCI applicant is 3.6 Science GPA and 3.5 CUM GPA with MCAT score of 32
- Five UCI students were admitted into MD PhD. Programs. Four out of the five admits were offered admissions into multiple MD PhD programs. Two out of the five admits were offered admissions to more than 9 MD PhD programs including Ivy leagues schools.
- 2011 app cycle 60% of all UCI student applicants accepted only took the MCAT once. 85% of all UCI applicants accepted did not take the MCAT more than twice. 2013 app cycle, 15% of student that took the MCAT once were admitted. Trend shows that more students taking the MCAT for the first time are not prepared.
- Majority of UCI applicants that matriculated with undergraduate GPA of less than 3.39 and variable MCAT score had additional unique attributes in their application such as; most had continued education course work- post baccalaureate and or graduate degree (M.S, M.A, Ph.D.), and likely were non-traditional applicants.
- Total of 40 UCI undergraduate alumni applicants with graduate degrees applied, of which 7 matriculated. Average undergraduate GPA BCPM & CUM for these applicants was 3.5 and a Graduate GPA for BCPM and CUM was 3.8.
- *We strongly encourage our student applicants to release their applications & MCAT scores to their school advisor. This data is accessible to you due to released scores from former and current UCI students. In the 2013 Application Cycle, a total of 467 UCI students applied and 127 were offered admissions. 69 students did not release their scores. Out of the 69 students that did not release their scores, 20 were accepted in medical school.*
